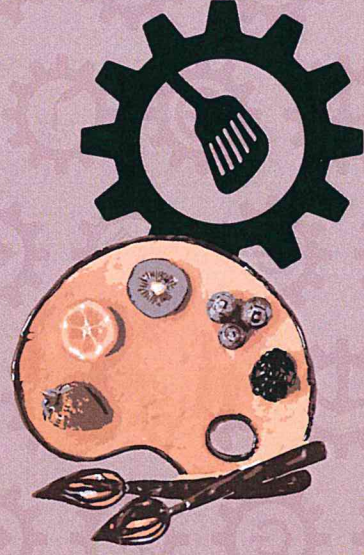

CTE Camp

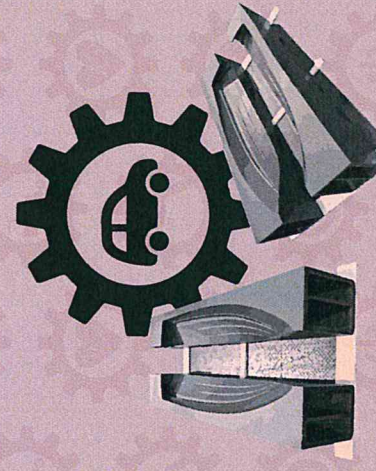
About the Camp Program

WCTC is proud to be piloting a CTE summer camp experience for Waldo county middle school students. The sessions, which run from 9:00 AM -3:00 PM, will begin on Monday, July 19th and end Friday, July 30th. Enrollment is on a first come first serve basis, and the cost for the two week session will be \$50/camper. Daily snacks and lunches will be provided and each camper will receive a complimentary T-shirt. Participants will have the chance to select a program of their choice, but may be placed in their alternate selection, based on previous sign-ups and enrollment caps. This experience will provide the students with the opportunity to learn more about **Career and Technical Education**, and what pursuing such a career path might look like for them in the future. 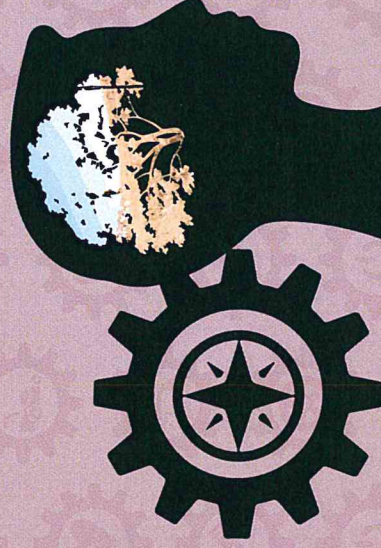
Culinary Arts

Campers will have the opportunity to learn basic cooking skills and nutritious food preparation, in a professional environment. Following an introduction to kitchen safety and food service sanitation, the instructor will lead students through the various food prep fundamentals, yet also allow for some creative expression and variability in their finished products.



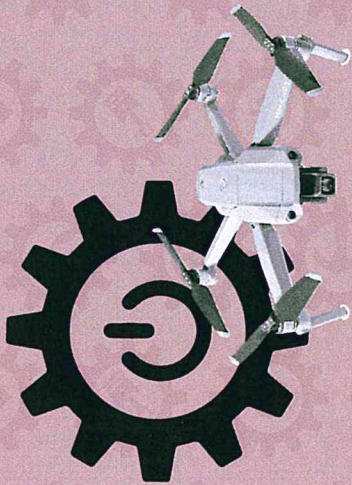
Composites (Carbon Fiber)

Campers will have an opportunity to learn the fundamentals of basic composite (carbon fiber) manufacturing, through the production of their own frisbee or boomerang. They will learn the same exciting principles used to produce everything from large boats to recreational toys (skateboards & snowboards) to smaller personal items, in this fast growing industry.



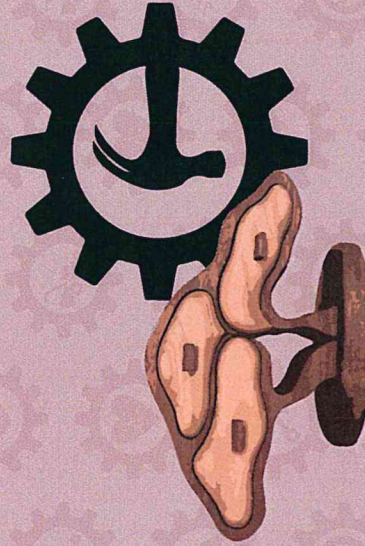
Outdoor Recreation

In this rare, yet important offering, students will learn the basics of camping and other points related to outdoor living, including but not limited to tenting, backpacking, fireside cooking and basic first aid. Given safe weather conditions, campers will also learn about canoeing, kayaking and fly fishing.



Computer & Info Technology

Students will have the opportunity to learn how computers and IT networking operate, as well as explore the various dimensions of robotics and drone technology. They will also be introduced to 3-D printing and CNC engraving, as controlled by high tech software programs.



Fine Woodworking (Week of July 19-23 only)

Following required safety training, students will have the opportunity to build one of two projects (lamp or wooden pen), which they will keep once finished. Throughout the experience, campers will learn the various measuring, cutting, wood joinery and finishing techniques, necessary to complete a quality wood craft product.
